Re: Letter of Support- St. Albert BMX SX Track

To whom this may concern,

Hello, my name is Tory Nyhaug and I am a 2x Olympic BMX Racer for Team Canada. I went to the London 2012 and Rio 2016 Olympic Games for BMX Racing. I became an Olympic finalist in Rio 2016 finishing 5th. I also won a Pan American Games Gold Medal in Toronto 2015, Finished on the UCI BMX SX World Cup podium 6 times throughout my career, as well as won 13 Canadian National Championship titles.

I am writing this letter in support of the BMX SX track in St. Albert Alberta. BMX SX came into effect in the early 2000's as BMX was set to be in it's first Olympic Games in 2008. At that time, there were few permanent BMX SX tracks in the world as it was a new Olympic sport. Fast forward to today and most countries around the world have their own world class BMX SX track for their athletes to train on. Currently in Canada, we have 2 BMX SX tracks in Abbotsford, BC and Toronto, Canada. Both are utilized by riders in those respective places.

I have coached BMX clinics in Alberta since 2018, and currently personally coach a handful of riders in Alberta, and I can say from my own experience that there is a vast talent pool in the province. Many riders in Alberta are currently making finals and/or winning USABMX Nationals which are some of the most competitive races in the world. In addition to that, riders from Alberta have become World Championship finalists and have announced themselves on the world stage. Very few riders ever get to this level in their amateur/professional career, which is a remarkable feat.


Currently there is nowhere for these riders from Alberta to train/develop themselves on an Olympic caliber track. I am currently training Molly Simpson who is a Canadian National Team member, World Cup medalist, and 2024 Olympic Hopeful who has nowhere to train in Alberta. She must travel to BC or California to properly train and prepare for the Olympics. This it but one example of a world class rider that would greatly benefit from having a proper BMX SX track to train on in Alberta. The riders need a facility in Alberta to train on, and I can't think of a better idea than to have their own BMX SX Track.






